

Cornerstone Church Liverpool Covid-19 Guidelines

As we run the Little Pebbles tots groups in the Ramilies Road Cornerstone Liverpool building, there are a number of guidelines we need to ask you to adhere to whilst in and around the building in order for everyone to be 'Covid-safe':

- Firstly, if you or anyone you have been in close contact with are experiencing Covid-19 symptoms, please do not attend.
- Upon arrival at the building, please use the main entrance to enter the building, but keep a social distance between others in the queue of people (if there is a queue) and please be wearing your mask ready to enter.
- The leader of the session will be on the door to direct you to sign the attendance list so that we can have a fully accurate track and trace record. There will be hand sanitiser on the table with the list, so please ensure you sanitise after signing the record.
- Prams and pushchairs will be placed in the side room by one of the leaders - please use a wipe provided to sanitise the pram handle(s) before handing it over (leaders will have done likewise with their hands), and you can then make your way into one of the sections of the main room that can hold up to 6 people in it. Seats and toys provided there will have been sanitised before the session begins.
- If the toilet is needed or other movement around the room is necessary, please walk in a way which limits proximity to other people in the room. We must endeavour to not have more than 6 people in anyone section of the room at any time apart from when people are passing through or leaders are coordinating the session.
- There is only one toilet in use currently (the disabled toilet) to reduce the cleaning burden. In the toilet there is provided a range of cleaning equipment, so you can clean anything down in the toilet before using it please do so. We also ask that if possible, please give the items used/touched a wipe over after you are finished in the toilet. At the end of every session that uses the church the toilet/basin/door lock & handle etc will be thoroughly cleaned down.
- The toys provided are for the children in your section to use, but if they move between children from different households/bubbles, please use one of the wipes provided (on a windowsill in your section) to wipe over the toys. We would also like to ask for your help in sharing this job at the end of the session.
- No provision of refreshments will be available. However, if you would like to bring your own drink/snack with you for you and/or your accompanying child that is completely acceptable.
- At all times whilst in the building you will be required to wear a mask unless you have a medical exemption which means you don't have to.
- There may be music being played in the room, but we have to ask you not to sing along, due to the current restrictions on Covid-19 guidelines.
- At the end of the session, you will be asked to leave the room via the fire exit door following instructions from the leader on movement around the room. There will be hand sanitiser provided near the exit door for you to use should you wish to.

Our hope is that by following these guidelines, you will be able to enjoy meeting together as a tots group once again and that the family support provided through doing so will be invaluable for all involved.
