

## **Cornerstone Church Liverpool Covid-19 Guidelines**

As we begin to run the Little Pebbles tots groups in the Dovedale Road Cornerstone Liverpool building following the guidance issued by the government in their 'road-map' out of lockdown, there are a number of guidelines we need to ask you to adhere to whilst in and around the building in order for everyone to be 'Covid-safe':

- Firstly, if you or anyone you have been in close contact with are experiencing Covid-19 symptoms, please do not attend.
- You will need to have pre-registered online, but if you haven't done so and there is space available (up to 15 adults are allowed in one session) then we can organise this as you arrive.
- Upon arrival at the building, please use the entrance on Olivedale Road to enter the building but keep a social distance between others who may also be entering at the same time as you and please be wearing your mask ready to enter.
- The leader of the session will be on the door to direct you to use the hand sanitiser on the table with the list, so please ensure you sanitise after signing the record.
- Prams and pushchairs will be placed in an area on the left-hand side of the main hall as you enter.
- Seats and toys provided in the main hall will have been sanitised/quarantined before the session begins.
- If the toilet is needed or other movement around the room is necessary, please walk in a way which limits proximity to other people in the room.
- There is one toilet section available for use for Little Pebbles currently which has two toilets in it. We ask that if more than one person wants to use the toilets at the same time that you endeavour to keep distance between yourselves in there. As we don't have separated male and female toilets currently, these toilets are to be used primarily by females and accompanying children (either gender). There is an additional toilet in a separate room which a worker can show any adult males to if male toilet provision is required. In the toilets there is a range of cleaning equipment provided so that you can clean anything down in the toilet before using if you wish to do so. We also ask that if possible, please give the items used/touched a wipe over after you are finished in the toilets. At the end of every session that uses the church the toilet/basin/door lock & handle etc will be thoroughly cleaned down.
- The toys provided are for the children in your section to use, but if possible could we ask you to help minimise the spread of any potential Covid 19 by wiping down toys your child has used with the wipes positioned around the room? We would also like to ask for your help in sharing this job at the end of the session.
- No provision of refreshments will be available as we initially open as we have to follow the same guidelines as cafes and until they open for indoor service we are not allowed to serve drinks etc. However, if you would like to bring your own drink/snack with you for you and/or your accompanying child that is completely acceptable.
- At all times whilst in the building you will be required to wear a mask unless you have a medical exemption which means you don't have to or unless you are drinking/having a snack.
- At the end of the session, you will leave through the same door you arrived at onto Olivedale Road, please keep your distance from others as you depart and feel free to use the hand sanitiser provided near the door should you wish to do so.

Our hope is that by following these guidelines, you will be able to enjoy meeting together as a tots group once again and that the family support provided through doing so will be invaluable for all involved. As restrictions alter and ease, we will update you on any changes to these guidelines.
